Art. 1 Purpose of this Admission Call

1. This call for applications regulates admission to the following Double degree programs held in English for the academic year 2026/2027 at the Department of Information Engineering and Computer Science at the University of Trento:

- Computer Science
- Computer, Communication and Electronic Engineering

2. The double degree program has reserved a maximum number of positions for applicants:

Art. 2 Admission requirements

1. Applications are accepted to the selection process from those who satisfy the following requirements:
 - a. The candidate must be a student of the following two departments of the School of Information Technology and Electronics, the National University of Mongolia.
 - Department of Information and Computer Science
 - Department of Electronics and Communication Engineering
 - b. At least 90 credit hours must be completed at the National University of Mongolia, of which 60 credit hours must be completed in the [course mappings](#) (The current semester will be counted)
 - c. GPA of 3.0 or higher
 - d. English language score (TOEFL, IELTS, and TOEIC score equivalent to at least a B2 level of the Common European Framework)

Art. 3 Application procedures and deadlines

1. Candidates seeking admission to the selection process must complete the [online application form](#).
2. Submitting applications must be made according to the deadline: **1 May 2026 at 23:59 (GMT+8)**.
3. Technical problems in filling out the online application must be immediately emailed to gantulga_g@num.edu.mn. Applications submitted after the application deadline and/or in a different way than those expressed in Article 3

4. To complete the online application correctly, candidates must upload the following documents in PDF format:
 - a. A copy of a valid national identity card (only pages relating to personal information);
 - b. Motivation letter – A statement outlining your motivation and reasons for participating (400-600 words in English)
 - c. Completed courses in the [course mappings](#) (The current semester courses will be counted, and at least 90 credit hours must be completed at NUM) and study plan (List of courses studied at NUM and to be studied at the University of Trento in the 4th year)
 - d. Transcript of all courses. The transcript must include the list of all marks obtained and the GPA (available from SiSi in English and Mongolian).
 - e. Document proofs of English Language score
 - f. Curriculum Vitae (in [Europass](#) format, photocopy of any certificates or other relevant documents can be attached, if applicable)

Art. 4 Selection and ranking

1. The evaluation committee (hereinafter the Committee) for the applications received comprises at least three faculty members from the two joint Universities.
2. The Committee checks the regularity of the submitted applications and, for the eligible candidates only, evaluates the fulfillment of the curricular requirements and the adequacy of the candidate's preparation. The Committee may meet remotely as well.
3. The evaluation will be carried out by assigning a score out of 100 based on the following criteria:

| Criteria | Score |
|-----------------------------|-----------------|
| a. Motivation letter | Up to 20 points |
| b. GPA | Up to 60 points |
| c. Language competence | Up to 10 points |
| d. CV, other certifications | Up to 10 points |

Suppose the documents in the online application do not allow the Committee to evaluate the candidature adequately. In that case, the candidate might be asked to participate in an interview (in person or via video conference) or to submit further documentation/certificates.

4. Applicants awarded a score of **50/100 or more** will be considered eligible.
5. On completing the evaluation process of each Call, the Committee will publish the ranking list **by 6 May 2026** on the [webpage](#).



Art. 5 Admission and enrollment

1. Candidates who intend to renounce their place must notify the Committee as soon as possible by e-mail to gantulga_g@num.edu.mn.
2. Should any places become available, the Committee reserves the right to invite other suitable candidates from the ranked list to enroll in the Double degree up to the number of places available.
3. Information about each Double degree program enrollment will be provided to gantulga_g@num.edu.mn in due time. Students who do not complete enrollment by the deadline will be considered withdrawals.

Art. 6 Tuition fees

1. The student pays the tuition fee to the Home University according to its credit rate for the entire duration of the study. No additional fees are payable to the Host University.

Art.7 Scholarships

1. A top candidate may be awarded a full scholarship under the Erasmus+ KA 171 ICM program, including monthly allowance (which covers accommodation), and round-trip airfare.
 - for two semesters (10 months)
 - € 900 (€ 1,025 for disabled person, national minority) stipend per month, from which the candidate is responsible for paying their own accommodation costs
 - Covers round-trip travel
2. A runner-up top candidate may be awarded a half scholarship under the Erasmus+ KA 171 ICM program, including monthly allowance ((which covers accommodation)), and round-trip airfare.
 - for one semester (4-5 months)
 - The candidate will cover the next semester's expenses
 - € 900 (€ 1,025 for disabled person, national minority) stipend per month, from which the candidate is responsible for paying their own accommodation costs
 - Covers round-trip travel
3. The selected candidates without scholarships will study in Italy for one year at their own expense.
